Cause of Action:

Respondent's current behavior and course of practice represents an immediate and significant danger to the public health, safety and welfare.

Emergency Order:

Respondent's application to renew his licenses to practice as a physician/surgeon and to administer and prescribe controlled substances was denied. It should be noted that Respondent's licenses expired on January 31, 2008
