To All Utah Professional Engineer, Professional Structural Engineer, and Professional Land Surveyor Licensees:

A change to the General Rules of the Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (Title R156-1-308a) changed the expiration date of all Utah Professional Engineer, Professional Structural Engineer, and Professional Land Surveyor licenses from December 31 of each even-numbered year to March 31 of each odd-numbered year (2007, 2009, etc).

Therefore, any active Professional Engineer, Professional Structural Engineer, and Professional Land Surveyor license, as of December 31, 2006, will be automatically extended an additional three months to March 31, 2007.

DOPL will NOT send out new license certificates reflecting the extended expiration date.

Instead, this letter serves as official documentation of the extension and must be kept with your blue license certificate. It is also recommended that a copy of this letter be given to your employer(s), if applicable. Additional copies of this letter are available at www.dopl.utah.gov.

CONTINUING EDUCATION: Please be aware that the continuing education cycle for these professions has NOT changed, but remains at 24 hours for each two-year period (January 1, odd-numbered years through December 31, even-numbered years). The next continuing education cycle will run from January 1, 2007, to December 31, 2008, and every two years thereafter.
