been made to the probation program.

Dan Jones reviewed Mr. Probst's file with the board. Mr. Probst is requesting termination from probation. Following a review with the board, a motion was made by Chad Nay to release Mr. Probst from probation. The motion was seconded by Joe Thalman. Following further discussion, the motion was amended to include "provided the Division receives the quarterly report from Mr. Probst's supervisor". The motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSS RULE CHANGE FOR SCOPE OF PRACTICE FOR INSPTECORS

Dan Jones explained why this change is needed and the reason for this proposal for the scope of practice for residential electrical inspectors. Ryan Jackson spoke to the board in favor of the proposal.

During the discussion of this proposal, Joe Thalman was excused at 10:56.

Following the discussion by all present, a motion was made by Roger Evans that if the electrical portion of the IRC is removed and replaced with the NEC, then as of January 1, 2010 the ICC residential electrical inspector exam is no longer valid. The motion died due to the lack of a second.

Following further discussion, Scott Marsell made a motion to approve the proposed amendment as far as the licensure change but without taking a position on the state code amendment. The motion died due to a lack of a second.

After additional discussion, Chad Nay made a motion to take no position at this time. The motion was seconded by Roger Evans and the motion passed with a vote of two in favor and Scott Marsell voting in opposition.
