DECISIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:

The Board reviewed minutes from June 7, 2007.
Dr. Peterson motioned to accept the minutes, seconded
by Dr. Park. The motion carried.

DISCUSSION:

Mr. Ormond reviewed the changes within the Division
with the Board. Dan S. Jones helped with the revision
of the proposed rules and Ms. Connie Call is the
Probation Coordinator.

Ms. Call briefly reviewed the process in monitoring
and tracking the Division probationers.

Appointments:

Dr. Gary Durrant presented himself to the Board. Mr.

Ormond conducted the interview. Mr. Ormond advised Dr. Durrant as of February 4, 2008, he will be the Bureau Manager over the Veterinary Board. Mr. Ormond stated he has reviewed Dr. Durrant's file and noted its deficiencies, i.e. fines not paid, has not submitted results of the Psychological Evaluation report, monthly or quarterly employer reports, required additional continuing education, and because Dr. Durrant has not been in compliance with his Stipulation, Mr. Ormond is going to refer it to Investigations for an 'Order to Show Cause'. Mr. Ormond advised Dr. Durrant that pursuant to the Stipulation and Order his license was revoked and the revocation was then stayed, but required him to meet the requirements of the stipulation and encouraged Dr. Durrant to start gathering the documents required and come into compliance with this stipulation and not wait until he receives the letter regarding the 'Order to Show Cause' hearing

Mr. Dan S. Jones expressed a concern regarding the wording in the Statutes 58-28-102, Definitions, (15)(b) "Veterinarian-client-patient relationship". Mr. Dan S. Jones stated the Board may want to revise this wording to better describe the Boards intent.

Dr. Peterson motioned to accept the proposed rule with changes, seconded by Ms. Smith. The motion carried unanimously.
