#### **MINUTES**

Mr. Lund made a motion to approve the February 2010 Board meeting minutes as written. Mr. Allis seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.

#### **EDUCATION & ENFORCEMENT FUND**

The education and enforcement fund was reviewed. Mark Steinagel, the Director of the Division, in the October meeting indicated the board could presently use the fund once a year to send a single Board member to the annual ASBOG meeting. The ASBOG meeting this year is to be held in Saint Louis, Missouri from November 4-6. Mr. Lund was appointed by the Board to attend this annual meeting.

#### **Workshops**

Niall Henshaw of the Association of Engineering Geologists was not present. However, the Board was of the impression that he was going to be there to present a request to fund a workshop.

The Board discussed helping to fund a workshop on professional responsibility. This topic, in addition to a workshop, needed further discussion at other training seminars. The board suggested broadening the training by having the workshops video taped. Daniel Horn suggested taking workshops to the universities. This was discussed at the previous

meeting. He had already contacted BYU and SVU and they expressed support.

Mr. Loughlin stated he would look into coming up with other training presentations that may be available through Mr. Armstrong, a previous Board member, and Mr. Henshaw. The Board would work to have training presentations in place for this fall or next spring.

## **ENFORCEMENT**

The Board discussed that both education and enforcement were needed to maintain a high standard of professionalism. Enforcement was essential and licensees had an obligation to report improper practices by other licensees.
