The minutes from the December, 2010 meeting were reviewed. Mr. Weight made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Mr. Burton seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Probation Update

Ms. Bowen provided a probation report for the Board to review. Twenty four electrical licensees are on probation. Nineteen of the licensees are in compliance with the terms of their probation, five licensees are non compliant. Letters will

be sent to the licensees out of compliance. An Order to Show Cause will be drafted by the Attorney General's office for Frank Montoya, Sr.

Mr. Weight made a motion to terminate probation for Eric Craig Lewis. Mr. Burton seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Weight made a motion to require a drug screen for Kelly Hardman. Mr. Clubb seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Investigation Update

Mr. Jones reviewed the renewal information and criminal history for Matt Beckstead. Misrepresentations were made on the renewal form. Mr. Beckstead answered questions from the Board. Mr. Weight made a motion to issue a \$500 citation for misrepresentation. Mr. Burton seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote. His apprentice license will be reinstated once he finds employment and the fine is paid.

Jasen Stuart Hamilton
Journeyman Electrician

Mr. Jones reviewed the reinstatement application and criminal history for Jasen Hamilton. Mr. Hamilton answered questions from the Board. Mr. Weight made a motion to offer a MOU to reinstate his license. The length of the probation will be five years. Mr. Clubb seconded the motion. Mr. Burton suggested probation for more than five years. Motion passed with four votes in favor. Mr. Burton voted against the motion.

Christopher Peterson
Apprentice Electrician

Mr. Jones reviewed the reinstatement application and the criminal history for Christopher Peterson. Mr. Peterson answered questions from the Board. Mr. Burton made a motion to assess a \$500 fine for unlawful conduct and misrepresentation on his renewal form. He will need to pay the fine within 90 days. The probation will be for three years. His license will be conditionally renewed until February 28, 2011 to allow time to draft the Stipulation and Order. Mr. Weight seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Ryan Robertson
Apprentice Electrician

Mr. Jones reviewed the apprentice application and criminal history for Ryan Robertson. Mr. Robertson answered

questions from the Board. Mr. Weight made a motion to offer a probationary license. Mr. Robertson will need to submit a mental health evaluation. He will be restricted from working on job sites where minors are present. His license will remain on probation until he is no longer on the sex offender registry. The Board requested he submit to a drug screen today. Mr. Clubb seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
