Ms. Laurie Noda from the AG's Office was present at

the Board to address the situation. Ms. Noda stated that because the Law has no wiggle room as far as the six-month internship, Ms. Smart would need to complete the full six months to fulfill the requirement for licensure as a Veterinarian.

Administrative Rule

Mr. Ormond presented proposed rules with changes to R156-28-302c, which eliminates the Division from pre-approving applicants for the exam and R156-28-502-3, Unprofessional Conduct to update to the 2011 revisions.

Dr. Heaton seconded by Dr. Rood made a motion to make the two changes as proposed. The motion carried unanimously.

Legislation Issues HB 243

H.B. 243 stated that a Board member can serve up to six months after their term has ended.

The Division now has citation authority to fine an unlicensed individual up to \$1000.00 for the first offense.

The Board suggested adding internship to the next Board meeting agenda. Dr. Rood stated he would notify the UVMA at their next association meeting.

The Board also suggested inviting Dr. De Carolis from AVIC to the next Board meeting to address accreditation in conjunction with the internship program.
