DECISIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Kevin Clubb was selected as the new board chairman.

Mr. Shaffer made a motion to approve the minutes for September as amended. Mr. Kingery seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Kingery made a motion to approve the August minutes as written. Mr. Shaffer seconded the motion. Motion passed with three votes in favor. Mr. Allred did not vote.

The Board reviewed the list of continuing education courses approved since the August meeting.

A Notice of Agency Action has been filed for Pellco. The Construction Services Commission will review at their meeting on October 31.

Mr. Furlong gave an investigation update. The investigators will begin writing citations for advertising by unlicensed people.

Ms. Bowen reported there are fifty electricians who are compliant with the terms of their probation, two electricians who are not in compliance with the terms of their probation. Notices of Agency Action have been filed on six individuals who have been non compliant for several months.

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Jeremy McCollum. Mr. McCollum answered questions from the Board. Mr. Shaffer made a motion to approve the license on probation for four years with the standard provisions. The license will not be approved until it has been one year since his last arrest. Mr. Allred seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Guy Johnson. Mr. Johnson answered questions from the Board. Mr. Kingery made a motion to terminate probation. Mr.

Allred seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Michael Warren Jr. Mr. Warren answered questions from the Board. Mr. Shaffer made a motion to approve the Stipulation as written. Mr. Allred seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Scott Daniels
Request Release from Probation

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Scott Daniels. Mr. Daniels answered questions from the Board. Mr. Shaffer made a motion to terminate probation. Mr. Allred seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Richard Rojas
Journeyman Exam Approval

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Richard Rojas. Mr. Jones is concerned that Mr. Rojas has not successfully completed a sex offender treatment program. Mr. Rojas answered questions from the Board. Mr. Kingery made a motion to require a mental health evaluation before Mr. Rojas can be approved to take the exams or be approved for an apprentice license. Mr. Shaffer seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Tyler Durrant
Probation Interview

Ms. Bowen reviewed the history for Tyler Durrant. Mr. Durrant is requesting early release from his probation. He answered questions from the Board. The Board did not recommend termination of probation.

The Brahma Group Inc
CE Provider Approval

The Brahma Group Inc. requested approval as a continuing education provider. Jim Lindsay explained the course and the way it would be taught. Mr. Allred made a motion to approve the Brahma Group Inc with the condition the course be held at a location accessible to all licensees. Mr. Shaffer seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Brett Lorscheider
Apprentice

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Brett Lorscheider. Mr. Lorscheider answered questions from the Board. Mr. Kingery made a motion to recommend probation for two years with the standard provisions. Mr. Allred seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

John "Jeremy" Erickson
Apprentice Reinstatement

Mr. Jones and the Board reviewed the history for Jeremy Erickson. Mr. Erickson answered questions from the Board. Mr. Shaffer made a motion to reinstate the license on

probation for three years with the standard provisions. Mr. Kingery seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

TIC

Rob MacCarthy from TIC - The Industrial Company met with the Board to discuss their education program. He gave a brief presentation of their program. He requested information on any programs approved since the rule change in 2009. No programs have applied for approval since the rule went into effect in 2009. Mr. Stevens emphasized that a Department of Labor approved program does not necessarily meet the requirements of Utah. A DOL approved program is used on federal jobs. Mr. Shaffer feels it is conflict of interest to have a contractor also be an approved education program. Mr. Allred made a motion to deny the request from TIC to be an approved education program. Mr. Shaffer seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
