A motion was made by Kurt Brooks to approve the minutes from the March 20, 2008 meeting as written. The motion was seconded by David Wesemann and passed unanimously.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

**REVIEW THE ELECTRICAL PORTION OF  
THE 2009 IRC**

Following the discussion by all present, a motion was made by David Wesemann to make a recommendation that the 2009 IRC be adopted and that Section VIII of that code is the one and two-family dwelling standard for electrical wiring in the state of Utah. Kurt Brooks seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Kurt Brooks that no matter which code is determined to be the prevailing code, there needs to be a clarification by rule of which one of the codes will be the prevailing code during the time period when the IRC and the NEC are not in sync. The motion was seconded by David Wesemann and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion was then made by Than Quist to recommend that during the period of time when the adopted IRC has not yet incorporated the latest residential electrical provisions contained in the adopted NEC, the adopted NEC provisions shall prevail as the adopted residential electrical standards applicable to installations applicable under the IRC. The motion was seconded by Kurt Brooks and passed unanimously.
