MINUTES:

A motion was made by Clark Peterson to approve the minutes from the July 8, 2008 meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Dave Webster and passed unanimously.

Dan Jones explained that there had been a change in the way the Division is going to handle meeting

minutes. If the next meeting is more than 30 day away, the minutes will be posted on the DOPL website as “pending final approval”.

Those present discussed the current amendment to the IRC in R156-56-802 (22). A motion was made by Clark Peterson and seconded by Dave Webster to recommend that the current amendment be forwarded on to the 2009 code. The motion passed unanimously.

The current amendment to the IFGC in R156-56-805 (1) was reviewed. Following a discussion by all present, a motion was made by Dave Webster to delete the current amendment. The motion was seconded by Clark Peterson and passed unanimously.

The current amendment to the IFGC in R156-56-805 (2) was reviewed. A motion was made by Dave Webster to recommend that the current amendment be forwarded on to the 2009 code. The motion was seconded by Clark Peterson and passed unanimously.

The current amendment to IECC in R156-56-807(1) was reviewed. Following a discussion by those present, a motion was made by Dave Webster to recommend that the current amendment be forwarded on to the 2009 code. The motion was seconded by Clark Peterson and passed unanimously.

This committee is recommending that the 2009 IECC be reviewed at a joint meeting with the Architectural Advisory Committee. A meeting will be set up for June.

A motion was made by David Webster to make a recommendation to adopt the 2009 IMC, IFGC and the mechanical provisions of the IRC. The motion was seconded by Ray Moore and passed unanimously.

Dan Jones explained what the effect of the passing of SB 211 has on the adoption of the 2009 codes

and the effective date. The amendment process will remain the same for the advisory committees. The Commission will now be making a recommendation to the Business and Labor Interim Committee and the legislature will make the final decision.
