TOPICS FOR DISCUSSION

DECISIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Dan Jones reported to the committee that F. David Stanley had retired from DOPL and that Thad LeVar would be the interim director and the new director would Mark Steinagel. He also reported that Dan T. Jones has moved from DOPL Investigations to the Division of Corporations.

MINUTES:

A motion was made by Nathan Lunstad to approve the minutes from the February 5, 2009 as written. The motion was seconded by Ray Moore and passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

REVIEW PROPOSED LOCAL AMENDMENT FOR KEARNS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT SECTION 604.4 MAXIMUM FLOW AND WATER CONSUMPTION

Blake Anderson spoke to the committee in connection with the proposal for a local Kearns amendment. A motion was made by Kiran Bhayani to approve the local amendment for Kearns. The motion was seconded by Bill Green. During the discussion on the motion, Dan Jones pointed out that this is similar to a local amendment that went to public hearing and then did not get approved. Following further discussion by those present, the motion passed with a vote of five in favor and Mark Jenkins, Greg Hand, and Wesley Greenhalgh voting in opposition.

CONSIDER WHETHER OR NOT TO REVIEW IAPMO'S CODE IN DETAIL

Dan Jones gave an explanation of why this committee has been asked by the Commission as to whether or not to do an in-depth review of the 2009 Uniform Plumbing Code. Pete Crow spoke to the committee on behalf of IAPMO.

Dan Jones explained what the process for the code review, public hearing and legislative process will be now that Senate bill 211 passed. All review of the 2009 codes and current amendments has to be completed by the July meeting due to a change in the public hearing from November to October. All approval of codes, amendments and effective date is now in the hands of the legislature.

Ray Moore made a motion to not do a review of the 2009 Uniform Plumbing Code for the 2010 legislative session but to do a review for the 2011 legislative session. The motion was seconded by William Green and the motion passed with a vote of five in favor and Greg Hand and Mark Jenkins voting in opposition.

PLAN REVIEW OF THE 2009 INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE

Kerry Cramer suggested that due to time constraints the scope should be on the current amendments to determine if they are still needed.

amendments in R156-56-803 and after a discussion the following recommendations were made.
