MINUTES:

The minutes from the August 16, 2005 meeting were approved as written.

GENERAL DISCUSSION OF
AND ACTION ON THE 2006
IPC AND ALL EXISTING
AMENDMENTS

Dan Jones explained the tracking method that will be used for the November rule filing.

Wesley Greenhalgh gave a review of his assigned chapters of 2 and 3.

Greg Hand gave a review of his assigned chapters of 4 and 5.

Bill Green gave a review of his assigned chapters of 9-11.

Michael Moss gave the review of chapter 6 for Nathan Lunstad.

Each of the current amendments for the 2003 IPC in R156-56-707 were reviewed individually and compared to the 2006 IPC. Following a discussion of each current amendment, motions were made, seconded, and voted on. Motions unanimously passed to recommend to the Commission that the following amendments be deleted:

R156-56-707(4) section 202 definition for Cross Connection.

R156-56-707(8) Section 202 definition for Trap Arm

R156-56-707(11) Section 304.4 Opening for Pipes

R156-56-707(13) Section 305.8 Protection against physical damage
R156-56-707(15) Section 308.7 Anchorage and 308.7.1 Location
R156-56-707(18) Section 403.1 Title
R156-56-707(25) Section 424.5 Shower Valves
R156-56-707(62) Section 1002.2 Design of traps
R156-56-707(63) Section 1002.8 Recess for trap Connection

A motion unanimously passed for R156-56-707(18) to change Footnote f for Table 403.1 to Footnote e.

A motion unanimously passed for R156-56-707(27) Section 504.6.2 Material to recommend to the Commission that the words “Table 605.4” and “Section 605.4” be added to the amendment.

A motion unanimously passed to recommend to the Commission that R156-56-707(55) Section 608.16.10 Automatic and coin operated car washes be renumbered to Section 608.16.11.

Following the discussion of R156-56-707(64) Section 1003.3.5 Grease trap restriction it was agreed to table the decision until Kerry Cramer can give his review of this chapter.

A motion unanimously passed to recommend to the Commission that in R156-56-707(67) the NSF - standard referenced number be changed from 61-99 to 61-2003E and keep the amendment as modified.

A motion unanimously passed to table the review of the current amendments for chapters 7, 8 and appendix C until the next meeting.

Motions unanimously passed to recommend to the Commission that all remaining amendments, other than the ones covered above, be kept for the 2006 IPC.

The committee reviewed the current plumbing amendments to the IRC. Following the discussion, motions were made, seconded, and unanimously passed to make the following recommends to the Commission:

R156-56-711(5) Section 202 certified backflow preventer
assembly tester be kept
R156-56-711(6) Cross Connection be deleted
R156-56-711(24) Section P2602.3 Individual water
supply be kept
R156-56-711(28) Section P2902.1.1 Backflow assembly
testing be kept
R156-56-711(32) Chapter 43 Referenced standards be
kept

Discussion of the remaining plumbing amendments for
the IRC was tabled.

OPENINGS ON COMMITTEE

Dan Jones informed that committee that there has been
one name nominated to fill Dwight Hill's position. The
committee felt that this position should to be filled by
someone from a local health department rather than a
state agency.

A motion unanimously passed to recommend to the
Commission that the membership be changed to read "5
to 7 members" and open a position for a plumbing
engineer.
