TABLE R301.5 MINIMUM UNIFORMLY
DISTRIBUTED LIVE LOADS

Dave Pierson pointed out that the Commission would need more information such as who had the present code placed in the 2006 edition and why Utah should be different from other states and/or if this will go to the national level. Following the discussion, Stephen Cohen made a motion to table the decision until further research can be done. The motion was seconded by Bruce Palmer and passed unanimously. Anne vonWeller will look into the background for the code change.

SECTION 105.2 WORK EXEMPT FROM
PERMIT

Steve Hamblin spoke to the committee in connection with this proposal. He pointed out that this proposal is going to be submitted on the national level. Following a discussion on the proposal, a motion was made by Bruce Palmer and seconded by Don Barker to forward the proposed amendment on to the Commission with a favorable recommendation. IBC

SECTION 1609.1.1 DETERMINATION
OF WIND LOADS

William Dzvrick spoke to the committee in connection with this proposed amendment. Following a discussion by those present, the proposal was amended by adding the following: “for: (a) items 1 through 3 listed in Table 16-H of the 1997 Uniform Building Code” between the words “procedure” and “provided:”, and also adding or (b) items 4 through 7 listed in Table 16-H of the 1997 Uniform Building Code.” before the last sentence. A motion was made by Steven Cohen and seconded by Don Barker to forward the proposed amendment as modified on to the Commission with a favorable recommendation. The motion unanimously passed.
