Operative: Two different restorative procedures from a choice of the following four: 1. Direct Restoration Posterior Class II Amalgam 2. Direct Restoration Posterior Class II Composite 3. Direct Restoration Anterior Class III Composite 4. Indirect Restoration Posterior Class II Gold		
Periodontal Treatment: Perform scaling and root planning on one or two quadrants		
Endodontics: 4-hour timed exam which consist of endodontic treatment on two extracted teeth: one anterior tooth and one mulit-canal posterior tooth. The teeth are mounted in arches and treatment is done with arches mounted in a manikin.		
Patient Assessment & Treatment Planning (PATP): A case history <i>(including radiographs, photos, charting,</i>		

<p><i>medical history</i>) of one patient is provided. Using the information provided, you have one hour to develop a treatment plan.</p>		
<p>Perodontal Assessment, Diagnosis and Prosthodontics: Two computerized simulation exams:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Periodontal 2. Prosthodontics <p>Each exam consists of 50 multiple choice questions. Time allowed for the two exams, including a tutorial, is three hours.</p>		
<p>Testing Requirements: All Five Sections must be taken on the First Attempt. Failure of 1-2 sections allows the candidate to retake just the failed sections. Failure of 3 or more sections requires retaking the entire examination.</p>
